#### **Our Impact Mission - 'No child goes without at school.'**

The Smiling Child Impact Program ensures ALL children from all backgrounds and cultures, Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal, are not excluded from schooling experiences due to economic hardship, as we experienced in our childhoods.

Because of yesterday's lived experience we want to evoke change for the child of today.

Strengthening the emotional and social well-being of the child we ensure school children, who sit just above the poverty line and who are not eligible for funding assistance from government and NGO's, have access to resources to ensure they never feel excluded from school opportunities.

#### **Approved Use of Funds Purpose:**

The donation must be used by your school to provide school resources for enrolled individual children of all ethnic backgrounds, Aboriginal and Non-Aboriginal children in need, to ensure they do not miss out or feel excluded from their classmates during the 2024 academic year.

All monies to be disbursed in the said academic year. The disbursement of funds is at the discretion of the school Principal based on a greatest needs basis, benefitting as many children in need as possible. The monies can be used on the following:

- School excursions and incursions
- School uniforms
- Student resources; stationery, books, bags, etc

We ask that recipient schools submit a simple acquittal form in Term 4 week 8 to account for the distributed funds in the relevant academic year.
